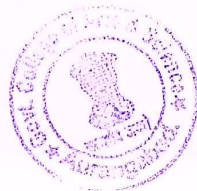


Date : 08 March 2018

International Women's Day Celebration

- Miss. Farooqui S.S. chairperson of ICC introduced the guest, Dr. Nirmala Jadhav, Director, Tarabai Shinde Study Center, Dr. BAMU and Mrs. Suvarna Umap, Deputy Commissioner, Damini Squad, Aurangabad City.

Dr. Nirmala Jadhav first gave a slight glimpse of harassment of women and then she spoke on how women could be empowered to overcome all their challenges and problems. She said that the first step is to educate girls and women so that they become aware and gain confidence once they are confident they can move forward in life. She said empowerment includes a sense of self worth, right to have and determine choices, access to opportunities and resources, power to control their own lives and ability to influence society for a




more just cause. She also discussed how women can be given more opportunities to earn and income, financial stability is one of the powerful tool in empowerment of women.

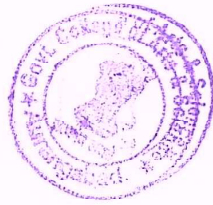
