NOW, THEREFORE it is mutually agreed and declared by and between THE PARTIES as under:

1. Both the above mentioned parties wishing to develop friendly and cooperative relation in the fields of education and research have agreed to establish the present MoU.

2. Subject of the agreement for the Department Of Zoology

- Joint educational training or research activity.
- Exchange of information in fields of interest to both parties
- Adopting new training technology.

- Providing free Software License which are product of "SECOND PART
- Arrange Mentors and Guest Lecturers from experts.
- Arrange Seminars, Workshops
- Campus Development.
- Campus Interview/ Placement



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. Guest Lecturers are specifically meant to deliver lecture or impart practical training. Mentor shall discuss/guide/counsel trainees in the institute as per mutual convenience. He can, however, also deliver lecture or impart training. Mentors are like role models for trainees and therefore, shall be experienced, skilled workers. The Mentors and Guest Lectures shall in all deliver minimum 2 programmes.

Terms and Conditions:

a. **Commencement /Expiration Date:** This MoU begins on the *effective date and expires on 11/11/2027 (maximum tenure shall not be more than 5 years from the effective date), unless terminated earlier in accordance with this MoU.*

b. **Participation in similar activities:** This MoU in no way restricts FIRST PARTY or SECOND PARTY from participating in similar activities with other public or private agencies, organizations, or individuals for same institute or other.

c. **Termination:** *Either party, upon thirty (30) days prior written notice, may terminate the MoU in whole, or in part, at any time before the date of expiration without liability to the other party. Further, either party may terminate this MoU, if the other party is in breach of this MoU and fails to cure such breach within ten (10) days after written notice to that effect. Notwithstanding such termination equipment's mentioned, infrastructure provided in compliance with clause No. and or as per the terms and conditions of this MoU by the SECOND PARTY, shall rest in the FIRST PARTY.*

Obligations of the parties;

1. Both sides will maintain on going communication and circulate essential information in a timely manner.
2. Both Parties agree that all financial agreement necessary to impliment this MoU must be neogociated and will depend upon the avalibility of funds. Neither institution shall have any finanacial obligations to the other institution based on this agreement.
3. Realisation of separate concret research projects within the frames of the MoU will be stupulated in separate specific agreements.

The Roles & Responsibility of the parties;

- 1 Each party acts on its own behalf in all relations with third party. Neither party will be responsible for any outside commitemnts of the other party.
2. Both institution subscribe to the policy of equl opportunity and do not discriminate on any basis , including but not limited to race , cast , sex, age, ethnicity , religion or National origin.
