On 'Fostering Teaching Learning Practices for quality enhancement in Higher Educational Institutions' Organized on 5th July,2021

Inauguration (10.30 am to 11.15 am)

The webinar began at 10.30. am sharp. *Joint Director of Higher Education, Aurangabad Region, Dr. Ranjitsinha Nimbalkar* was the inaugural guest and chief guest. *Hon. Dr. B. Raja Shekhar, Pro Vice-Chancellor of University of Hyderabad, Telangana* was the inaugural guest and resource person for the session. The webinar commenced with the recital of National Anthem Dr. Ranjit Sinha Nimbalkar delivered the inaugural address and emphasized the need of quality initiatives by educational institutions.

Dr.B. Rajashekhar congratulated for selecting teaching learning related topic for the webinar. He focussed on the volatility on the background of pandemic situation and expected changes in teaching learning practices.

Principal of the college *Dr.Rajendra*. *H. Satpute* welcomed the dignitaries and gave welcome speech. He gave a brief history of the college and also mentioned that the college is marching towards centenary and is expected to go for Autonomy. The convener of the webinar *Dr. Yugandhara Topare* read the foreword of the webinar. *Dr.Khan Talat Shaista* conducted the program.





Session 1- (11.15 am to 12.15 pm)

Measuring Quality Teaching and NAAC Accreditation Framework

For the first session *Prof. B. Raja Shekhar*, *Pro-Vice Chancellor*, *Hyderabad University*, *Telangana* was the Resource person. In his presentation he discussed about features of quality



teaching and how to measure quality teaching. He emphasized that active learning is becoming a biggest challenge. He explained that Students' satisfaction level is decided by the kinds of experiences students undergo. Extent of the comfort feeling as well as intellectual stimulation the learning situation provides. Their feedback showcases the actual quality of teaching learning process enabling identification of strength of teaching as well as the positive implements. He answered queries of the participants satisfactorily. Session was conducted by Dr. Seema Bodkhe.



Session 2- (12.30 am to 1.30 pm)

Teaching Learning Practices and NEP 2020

Dr. S. Shankar, Ex. Principal, ANR College, Gudivada, Andhra Pradesh was the resource person for second session. In his presentation he explained the Vision for India's higher education system. He focused that education in NEP 2020 will not be only for the employment but it will be for progressive and prosperous nation. He discussed some of the major problems in higher education system such as severely fragmented structure, poor learning outcomes, rigid separation of disciplines, lack of access, lack of institutional autonomy. HEI should develop community engagement and service and to support school education. It will help to increase gross enrollment ratio by 2030. New policy looks forward for autonomy and flexibility in the functioning of educational institutions. This session was conducted by Dr. Archana Chapolikar.





Session 3- (1.30 am to 2.30 pm)

Teaching Learning Practices and Outcome Based Education

In this session *Prof. Kalpana Chavan, Xavier's Institute of education, Mumbai* was a resource person. She Started her presentation with concept of outcome-based education. She explained outcome Based Approach in detailed. While explaining OBE approach she told the difference between output and Outcome. Prof Chavan created awareness about pedagogical terms and outcome-based education. She explained Epistemology of Teaching. Prof. Chavan focused on problems of teaching methods implementation and education system related problems. Over all presentation was Interactive, informative and comprehensive. Prof. Chavan answered many doubts of participants. Mr. Sandeep Jogdand conducted the session.



Session 4- (2.30 am to 3.30 pm)

Curriculum Development and employability in HEI's

Dr. Vijay Joshi, Chief consultant RUSA, Maharashtra and ex principal, K. J. Somaiya college, Mumbai was the resource person for the last session. His speech has enlightened the participants how the development of curriculum is significant to increase the employability of students in view of gaps in skill levels of graduates and disconnection of qualification and skills. In this connection he also focused the issues of new educational policy and needs of inculcating certain types of skills among students and invading it curriculum to increase the employability among graduates. He has also presented the job landscape of future jobs. He focused on the importance of new skills such as active learning, resilience, stress tolerance, flexibility in curriculum. He explained the difference in terms employment and employability skills. According to him the economic and social foundation of higher education is eroding. He emphasized on collaboration across network and need of adapting multidisciplinary approach. Dr. Ramprasad Kale conducted the session.

Webinar Report on Institutional Autonomy: How and Why?

IQAC and autonomy committee of Government College of Arts and Science organised a webinar on "Institutional autonomy: How and why" on 14th June 2021 at 3:00 p.m. The speaker, Professor Usha Mukundan of R. Jhunjhunwala College Mumbai, gave a presentation on the importance of autonomy in colleges. She stated that initially the number of colleges were small and the affiliating University could effectively oversee the working of colleges, act as an examination body and award degrees on their behalf. But in the present scenario when the number of colleges are increasing it is becoming extremely difficult for the affiliating university to manage the different needs of the affiliated colleges. Therefore, colleges should seek academic autonomy to improve the quality of undergraduate education. Some colleges have the potential for offering program of higher level but could not do so. They do not have the freedom to modernise their curriculum or make them globally component and skill oriented to promote employability.

She also innumerate the terms and conditions of an autonomous University or autonomous college that is review existing courses, to reach address of assessment of students performance . conduct of examination and notification of results. Some faculty members asked their queries like should we go for complete autonomy from the beginning or should we go for academic autonomy, will it affect the strength of the college, what is the eligibility criteria for autonomy and the nature of financial assistance and related provisions. She satisfactory answer all the queries.



PRESENTION SESSION BY IQAC ASSESSMENT AND ACCREDITATION OF HEI (REVISED GUIDELINES OF NAAC) 07-12-2018

Principal and Chairperson (IQAC): Dr.Rohini Kulkarni-Pandhare

Co ordinator: Dr.Yugandhara S. Topare

The IQAC held presentation and Discussion session for the review of NAAC revised guidelines on 7th December 2018

The objectives of IQAC were to enunciate the new propositions of Annual Quality Assurance Report in relation to Self Study Report of NAAC.

- 1. The new AQAR format was explicated, according to benchmark and quality expected by regulatory bodies like MHRD,UGC,NAAC and Dr.Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University.
- 2. The initiatives to be taken and the strategies to be adopted were put forth for the next subsequent cycle of NAAC
- 3. The criterion allotted to each member was enunciated along with the plan of action by the members of IQAC.
- 4. Dr.Y.S.Topare introduced NAAC guidelines. She reviewed and propagated the recommendations of NAAC Peer Team. (August 2016)
- 5. Dr.Topare showcased the IQAC's role as a Nodal unit. She analyzed the present situation and suggested initiatives to be taken on the basis of NAAC recommendation report.

2nd Cycle NAAC Recommendation:

1. The first recommendation by NAAC peer team to introduce value added and job oriented UG & PG courses. Dr. Topare suggested and emphasized the importance of value added courses within the available infrastructure.



- 2. The second recommendation by NAAC peer team was to establish the English language Laboratory, Dr. Topare directed that the delegation of this responsibility is entrusted with RUSA committee.
- 3. The third recommendation was related with ICT facility, Dr.Topare suggested embarking upon the augmentation of Wi-Fi without any delay, though K-Yan instrument is being utilized for teaching and learning in various Science departments.
- 4. Dr. Topare reported that the college organized inter and intra institutional workshops and seminars. In the year 2017, twelve self-financed workshops and in the academic year 2018, three workshops were organized in the college.
- 5. The recommendation of transport facility by NAAC peer team is not realizable.
- 6. The central instrumentation laboratory development has been earmarked with RUSA fund.
- 7. The girls and boys hostellers have an advantage of new and improved infrastructural facilities which are viable.
- 8. Dr.Topare emphasized the need of Industry Institutional collaboration.
- 9. Dr.Topare appealed for alumni strengthening in order to generate alumni funds.

Post NAAC initiatives.

- 1. IQAC has developed a full proof system for documents compilation and organization of files.
- 2. IQAC cell propagated the utilization of ICT facilities to promote "Go Green Campaign"
- 3. IQAC cell ahs initiated internal academic audit.
- 4. IQAC cell has initiated mentor mentee scheme for curriculum enrichment.
- 5. IQAC organized a workshop to create awareness of "Intellectual Property Rights"
- An Orientation program was conducted to enlighten the faculty members and Non- teaching employees regarding the New Guidelines of NAAC on 8th November 2017.

The introduction session was concluded with absolute certainty considering the proposed NAAC recommendations.



The Explication of Seven Criteria by IQAC Members:

Criterion – I: Curricular Aspects

Criterion coordinator Mr. Ajaykumar Gandhi

Ajay Kumar Gandhi illustrated the metrics and key indicators for degree colleges affiliated to Dr.Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University. He proposed that the existing departments should include new post graduate courses. The online portals like NPTEL and SWAYAM can be effective mediums for curriculum enrichment and development of online certificate courses. The mechanism of feedback from the stakeholders should be made online by rendering separate space on college website. The methodology of TASC scale was conductive till present and feedback from the stakeholders' students, teachers and parents have been obtainable. IQAC has formulated feedback mechanism for the parents, alumni and teachers from the academic year 2018-19. The feedback mechanism for the employers should be formulated without any delay.

Criterion - II: Teaching, Learning & Evaluation

Criterion co coordinator Miss. Trupti Sapkale

Trupti Sapkale illustrated the metrics and key indicators which were vital to procure for the making scheme. The evolutionary ICT based methods of teaching by using G suite software; Social Medias like Face Book, Twitter, YouTube and WhatsApp can facilitate collaborative and participative learning. She propounded the concept of blended learning and flipped classroom for being a part of global community. The Board of Studies of Dr.Babasaheb Marathwada University can be proposed to initiate new hybrid courses for curriculum enrichment like Mathematical Music, Language Studies along with Cultural Studies. The Infrastructure of the college has to be improvised to foster ICT based augmented reality, virtual reality, artificial translation and intelligence, avatars, robotics for personalized and experiential learning.

Criterion - III: Research Innovations and Extension

Criterion coordinator Mrs. Suchita Bharambe

Mrs.Suchita Bharambe illustrated the metrics and key indicators of research. She propagated that research and innovation is vital element in academia. She

explicated that the faculty members should take up research projects, attend workshops and conferences to update themselves of recent areas of research and innovation. She propounded the documentation of each research activity. The publication of research should be verified and validated for being authentic.

Criterion - IV: Infrastructure and Learning Resources

Criterion coordinator Mrs. Sandeep Jogdand

Sandeep Jogdand illustrated the metrics and indicators of infrastructure. He proposed to improvise infrastructural amenities. He explicated that internet speed carries separate marks in the marking scheme so, to obtain appropriate score the internet facility has to be upgraded. He posited the requirement of ICT based classrooms. He propounded the appointment of Documentation Officer for maintaining digital repository and uploading digital documents. He fore grounded the automation of library by upgrading the software. He expounded that N-List consortium is being used but, there is a need to proliferate the purchase of E-books and books.

Criterion - V: Student Support and Progression

Criterion coordinator Dr. Seema Bodkhe

Dr.Seema Bodkhe illustrated the metrics and key indicators of Student Progression. She proposed the value addition programs for curriculum enrichment. She propounded various schemes and programs for holistic development of students such as Mentor – Mentee scheme, Introduction of Yoga, Communication Skills, Soft Skills. She explicated about the format registration of Alumni Association for the generation of funds.

Criterion - VI: Governance, Leadership and Management

Criterion coordinator Dr. Anuradha Nisal

Dr.Anuradha Nisal illustrated the metrics of quality indicative framework and explicated the institutional framework. She appealed that trainings and faculty improvement Programs are indispensible for teaching and Non-teaching employees. She explicated Assessment and Academic audit by intensifying the

importance of external audit. Dr.Topare enlightened the faculty members about the duration of external audit. Dr.Nisal expounded the present Internal Quality Assurance System corroborated by IQAC. Dr.Nisal pointed out that an office should adopt information management system. A la fin she enunciated about financial incentives for the facilitators to attend seminars and conferences.

Criterion - VII: Institutional Values and Best Practices

Criterion coordinator Dr. Yugandhara Topare

Dr.Y.S.Topare emphasized the role of criterion-VII in the qualitative development of the college. She enunciated the role of environmental consciousness and the use of renewable sources of energy to gain the prerequisites in the assessment and accreditation process. She stressed the importance of maintaining the data for non-renewable resources of energy. She emphasized that in the consecutive academic year the code of conduct for teachers as well as students will be followed. The college must render separate space for code of conduct handbook on the college's website. She explicated the nature of "Best Practices" in consideration of academic, administrative and organizational development. She explained that the focal point of the college is reflected through the distinctiveness and uniqueness of the "Best Practices" promulgated by the college.

 - 3) AjayKumar Gandhi and Dr.Kale, Faculty members of Chemistry and Psychology Departments respectively, suggested building an elevator and Restroom for specially able Faculty members.
 - 4) Dr.Rohini Kulkarni Pandhare, Principal, Government College of Arts and Science, Aurangabad enunciated about the initiatives which have

been taken under RUSA scheme i.e. Development of Language Laboratory, ICT enabled classrooms, Incubation centre, Lift facilities for the Specially – able faculty members for the college infrastructural development.

India also has highest rate of suicide and sexual abuse. Adolescence age is most disadvantaged, neglected, vulnerable and marginalized. The development of adolescent brain is influenced by nutrition and social environment. They also face sexual health risks due to early marriage and early pregnancy. Western patterns are now emerging in India like divorce, remarriage and change in cohabitation. The main cause of teen stress is negligient parents, high expectations in academics, absurd or deprived childhood and a demand for familial responsibilities.

After the keynote address, the Principal delivered the presidential address wherein she congratulated the department for conducting the conference and

stressed on the importance of the topic of the seminar and its relevance in day to day life.Smt.Madhuri Thote expressed the vote of thanks.

Smt.Asha Kitke introduced Dr.Nilima Sinha, the resource person for the first technical session.Dr.Sinha spoke about the psychological issues during adolescence.She stated that self-concept is very important in shaping later life. Parents should identify disruptive behavior of the child.The sources of conflict between parents and adolescents are conflict over friends, clothes, where to go, chosen activities, changing goals, use of internet and cell phones etc. Adolescents want to be heard, communication should be positive and encouraging. Parents should be careful about judgemental words. The resource person for the second technical session was Dr.Shobha Udipi. She explained the theme 'Adolescents are second window of opportunity. According to statistics, there are 250 million adolescents in India. Malnutrition is responsible for various physical disorders like stunted growth, anemia and menorrhagia etc.Smt.Asha Kitke expressed the vote of thanks for this session.

The resource person for post lunch and third technical session was Dr.Smita Awachar. She was introduced by Dr. Archana Choudhari. The topic of her presentation was 'Adolescent girls and social envirionment'. She stated that the first environment available to child is the mother's womb,next is the school environment.But unfortunately, healthy social environment is not always found in schools, colleges and other educational institutions. This results in social immaturity. It was a brain storming session. The chief guest of the valedictory function was Prasad Mirkale, deputy CEO, Women and Child welfare department, Aurangabad municipal corporation. In his speech he shared his experiences regarding the work of the department regarding adolescents and women welfare. The guest speaker of the valedictory function was Prof. Vishala Patnam. She was introduced by Smt.Surekha Bhavsar. Dr.Vishala Patnam stated that in every body there is an enemy within. In the first fourteen years of life a blue print is prepared which shows what type of adult a child will become. She elaborately spoke about the development of adolescents with the help of many examples. After her speech Smt. Godsay gave the summary of the conference. 
